The Treasurer's Report was received. The total income for the last month was \$206.20. The total expenses for the same period was 302.41, for a net loss of \$92.21 for the month.

Literature: chairperson reported that the bank balance is \$1,168.44. Stock was depleted after the Retreat and a new order will be made soon.

Special Events: The Fall Retreat will be October 17-19, 2014. Sally doesn't have all the information necessary to calculate whether there was a loss or gain from the Spring Retreat.

WSO/Region 6: Judy G. will be asked to bring the info on the next Regional Assembly to the June Intergroup Meeting. Applications for scholarships to the Regional Assembly on Saturday October 13, 2014, must be postmarked by July 15th. The Assembly is in Albany. The scholarship covers the cost of the meals and motel room. The Region will also reimburse for mileage and tolls.

Old Business: We will ask the backup who has the key for the post-office box.

New Business:

Joanne reported about the Columbine Center: The accommodations are two single rooms connected by a lavatory with a sink. There are sixteen handicapped rooms downstairs. There are two meeting rooms. The cost is \$45 per night, Breakfast is \$6; Lunch \$7.5 and dinners \$10.25. The kitchen staff is the same as that at Christ the King. The prices are about the same as Christ the King. We do not know how many people the Columbine Center can accommodate. Gail A at Christ the King handles the reservations for both places. So we can check with her. It was also decided that Stella Niagara is too far away and too expensive, so Joanne will not check out the facility.

Janet suggested that the Intergroup table the Public Information Committee for a Twelve Step Within Committee. Janet volunteered to chair the committee if someone can be found to take the Literature. Joanne and Sally would be interested in this and Carol S has also indicated she would be involved, too.

Victoria would like to have detailed job descriptions for each retreat job, so anyone taking a position could have a step by step guide of what his/her responsibilities are. We do have detailed job descriptions. We will try to find them.
